



1+3 Program

- **Description:**

- This program is for Freshmen
- Chinese Partner University (CPU) students attend one (1) year of study at CPU, then study at Missouri State University (MSU) for three (3) years to complete their both bachelor's degrees at CPU and MSU.
- Also please notice that the length of three (3) years of studies at MSU mainly depends on the number of credit hours you will take in each semester and also your each course successful completion.

Important Advice: Before apply for this program, please talk to your department or college in CPU about the credit hour transfer process and make sure all the classes you will take at MSU can be transferred toward to your degree in CPU.

3+1+ “1” Program

- **Description:**

- Chinese Partner University (CPU) students attend three (3) years of study at CPU, then study at Missouri State University (MSU) for one (1) year to complete their bachelor’s degree which will be awarded by the CPU. **A second one (1) year period at MSU is optional and it requires student to apply for master program and to get admitted in order to continue the second “1” period of studies.**
- Also please notice that the length of second “1” period of studies can be longer than one year
 - If your undergraduate major doesn’t match with that of your future master program, which might require some additional classes.
 - If you need to retake some failed classes.

3+1+ “1” Program

Study Plan:

- First 1 year at MSU:
 1. Finish the courses/credits required by your home institute in China in order to get your undergraduate degree granted by your home institute in China.
 2. Prepare for your future graduate studies. You might start to take some foundation classes (undergraduate level) required by master program, or graduate level classes (Senior Permission Required)
 3. Submit your Master Program Application

- Second 1 period at MSU:
 1. Continue your master program studies
 2. Prepare for your future career/study plans

2+1+1 Program

- **Description:**

- The Chinese Partner University (CPU) students attend two (2) years of study at the CPU, then study at Missouri State University (MSU) for one (1) year, and return to complete their degree at the CPU.
- After you graduate from your home institute, you also can come back to MSU for master program.
- You will be still eligible for International Partner Scholarship on your master program

2+1+1 Program

Study Plan:

- 1 year at MSU:
 1. Take the courses/credits can be transferred back to your home institute in China in order to get your undergraduate degree granted by your home institute.
 2. Talk to your advisor or different departments to start learning about master programs and the admission requirement.

- Back to home institute:
 1. Keep in touch with Office of China Programs staff to get most updated application information.
 2. Apply for MSU master program in the beginning of second semester of senior year at home university
